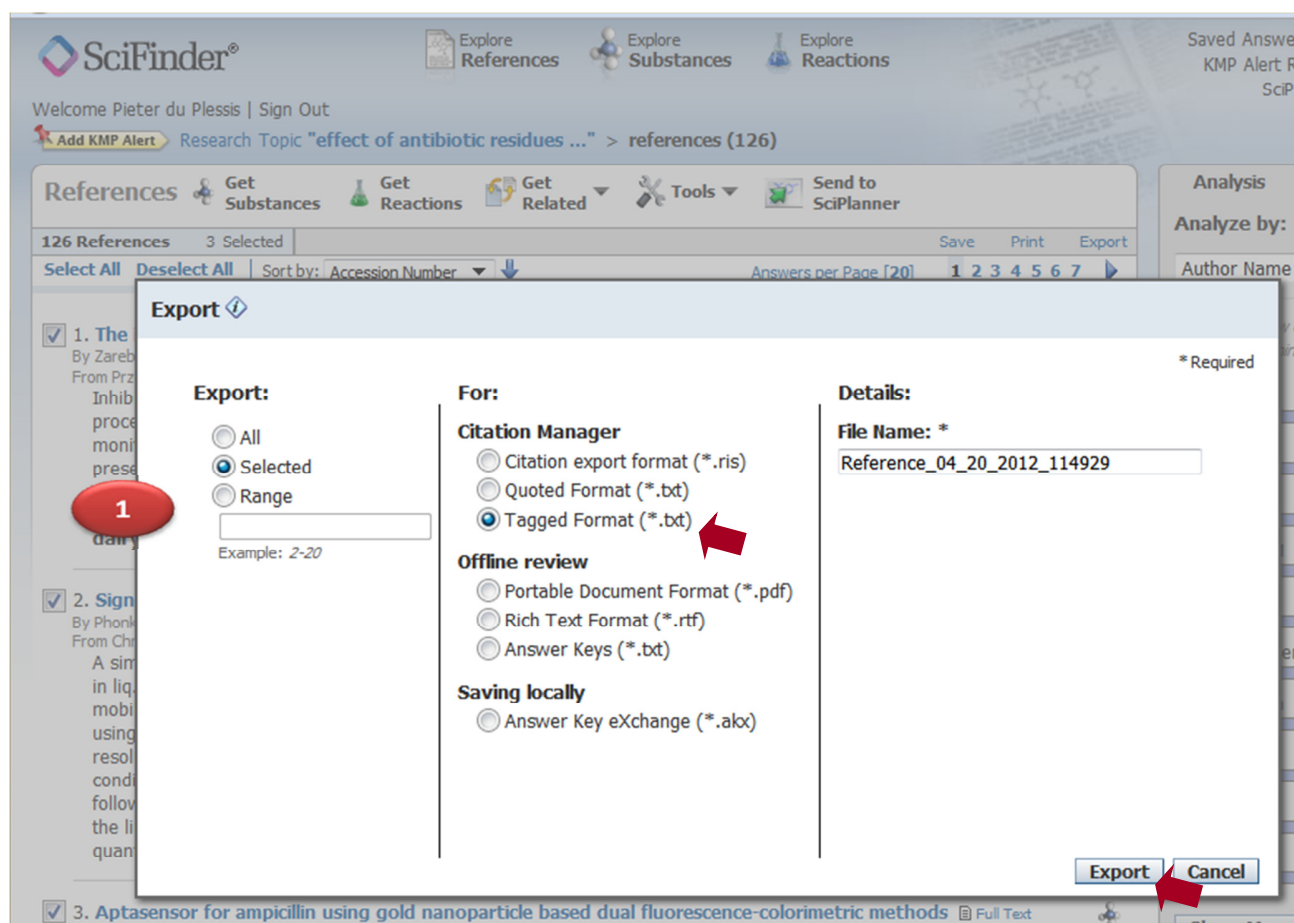




I. Importing references into RefWorks from SciFinder Scholar

In **SciFinder Scholar**, mark the relevant records.
From the **Export** option, select **Citation Manager: Tagged Format**.
Click on: **Export**.

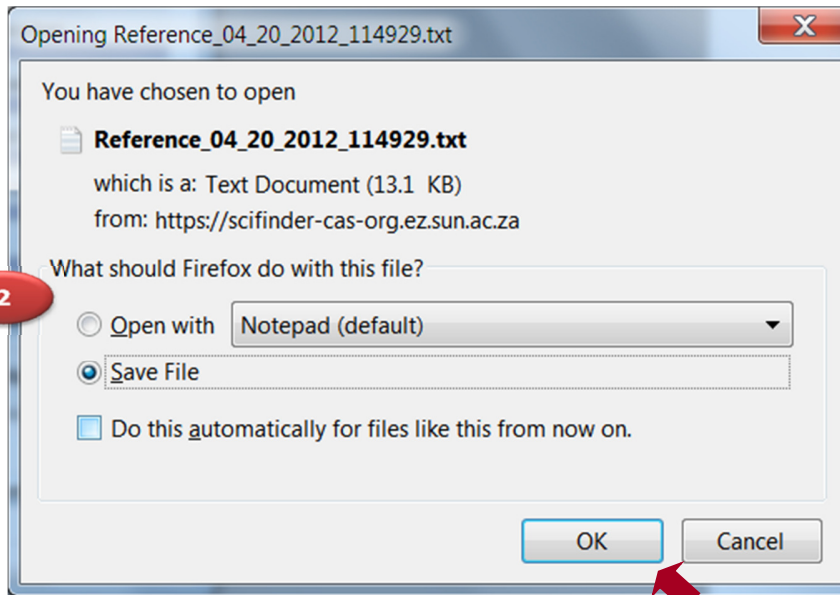
Merk die relevante rekords in **SciFinder Scholar**.

2. Saving references on desktop:

Save File and click on: **OK** to save the .txt document to your computer.

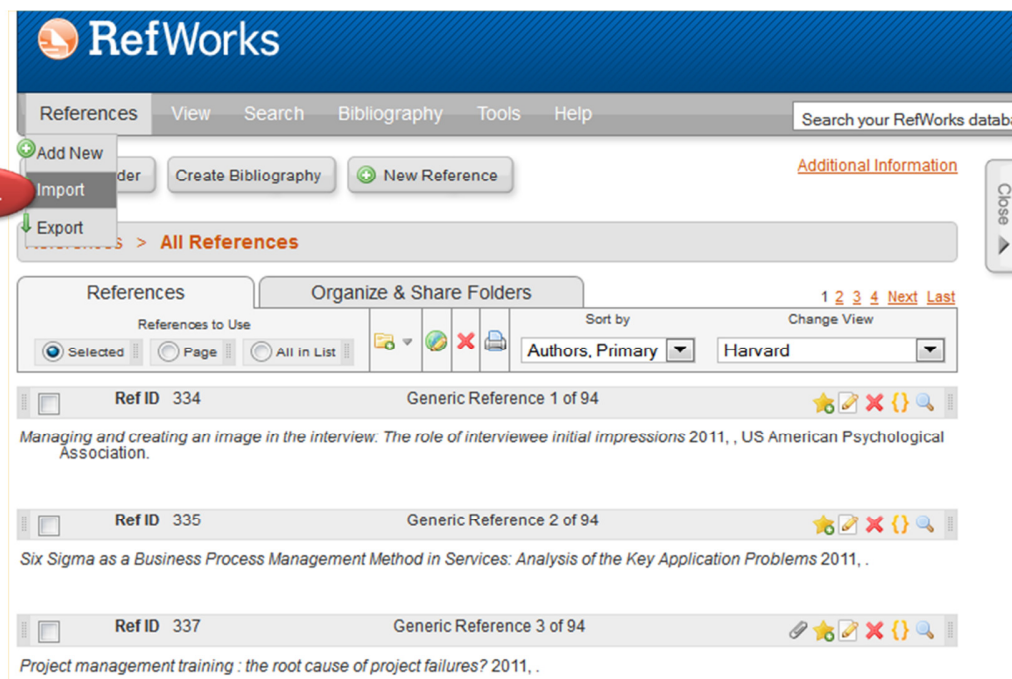
Save File en klik op: **OK** om die .txt dokument op u rekenaar te stoor.



3. Importing SciFinder.txt:

3.1 In RefWorks, click: **References – Import**.

Klik: **References – Import** in RefWorks.



- 3.2 Select **CAS SciFinder** as the Import Filter/Data Source and **Multiple Databases** as Database. **Browse** to find the **.txt** document you saved to your computer and click: **Open**.
Click: **Import**.
