DEVELOPMENT OF A DRG SYSTEM FOR OUTPATIENT PROCEDURES (NORDDRG-0)

SUMMARY

NordDRG is a common DRG system for the Nordic countries, based on the HCFA DRG system.

DRGs are intended for grouping inpatients but some County Councils in Sweden are using DRG also for grouping surgical outpatients, so called "day surgery". The grouping then often leads to a variety of conservative DRGs who are meaningless for describing surgery and a need for a better grouping system for these patients is obvious. The Swedish Centre for patient classification systems is developing a DRG system (NordDRG-0) based on the logic of NordDRG but intended for "day surgery" and other outpatient procedures like endoscopies. The work is still in progress but the paper presents the considerations during the development process. Some of the main principles are that all conservative groups and all complicated groups have been omitted resulting in a low number of groups. Approx. 45 new DRGs for endoscopies and minor procedures have been suggested. The new system will probably be available in the autumn 2002.

BACKGROUND

NordDRG was developed in the middle of the nineties as a common DRG system for the Nordic countries, based on the HCFA DRG system.¹ DRGs are intended for grouping inpatients but some County Councils in Sweden are using DRG also for grouping surgical outpatients, sometimes called "day surgery". The experience from Sweden is that NordDRG quite well describes "day surgery" in 50-60 percent of the cases and that is when the performed procedure is an operating room procedure (OR). The grouping then leads to the same surgical DRGs as for inpatients. In the rest of the so called "day surgery" patients the procedures are minor and usually not significant as cost drivers in inpatient setting. Logically they do not, and must not, affect the grouping of inpatients. Therefore, when NordDRG now is used for outpatients, the grouping often leads to a variety of conservative DRGs that are meaningless for describing "day surgery". There is obviously a need for a better grouping system for these patients.

THE AIM OF THE PROJECT

The aim of this project at the Swedish Centre for patient classification systems (CPK) is to construct a grouping system based on the logic of NordDRG but intended for "day surgery", including minor surgical procedures, and endoscopies, e.g. colonoscopy. Endoscopies are certainly not "surgery" but they often cost as much as a smaller operation and they are frequent procedures in many clinics. The reason way the work is based on NordDRG is twofold, firstly there is a strong request for following the development in surgery both in inpatient and outpatient settings, secondly the use of the standard

Casemix Systems

Since 1983, reimbursement for provision of inpatient medical care for certain types of patients (e.g., Medicare) in the United States has been based on DRGs. Subsequently, there has been an increased use of DRGs as a reimbursement mechanism by other payers as well, including managed care Organizations. Some states mandate use of other casemix methodologies to risk adjust clinical data. A few systems require data collection beyond the minimum Uniform Hospital Discharge

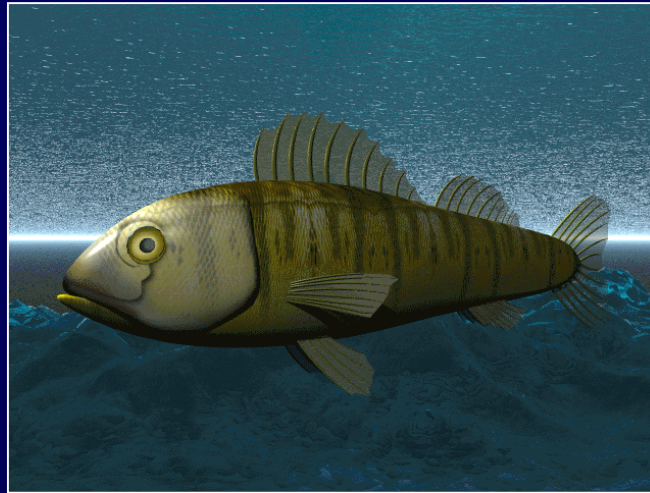

Data Set (UHDDS). Several multi-hospital Organizations, universities, and researchers apply the automated version of Disease Staging to their UHDDS data to adjust for clinical patient factors. Various other casemix methodologies are used in non-acute hospital settings.

Data Quality Issues

In the United States, there is great emphasis on correct coding. Clinical coding must be reliable, valid, complete, and timely¹³. Clinical data quality depends on the quality of medical documentation. Complex clinical documentation, inexperienced coding personnel, and illegible handwritten medical record entries all contribute to inaccurate classification. Errors in data, whether deliberate or accidental, have cost payers of healthcare services billions of dollars. A 1996 study of coding accuracy by the New Jersey Hospital Association is encouraging. Previous studies have shown accuracy rates as low as 80-88%. The New Jersey study of 126 separate audits in 33 hospitals showed accuracy rates between 95% and 100% for specific coding guidelines. Table 1 presents various the number and percent of error types for the 1,706 coding errors found, and shows the calculated accuracy rates for the various coding guidelines¹⁴. The U.S. federal government enacted the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) in 1996. This legislation seeks to reduce

Research questions and methods

The RASs may serve to identify streams of clientele, predict health care costs, and analyze resource utilization. The DRG and APC systems use procedures for surgical cases and diagnoses for medical cases : they represent the fulfilled offer of services, not necessarily the real needs or appropriate equitable demand of services. The DRG system has a prospective meaning only in the sense that payment is done prior to services. The RAS systems do not use, or use minimally procedures to regroup in a specific group. They use mostly diagnoses and co-morbidities. Not relying on services enable RASs to better estimate needs independent of services for sub-groups of population. This hypothesis is the main one to prove or disprove in this research project, as much as comparing of the main commercial tools available. They may also improve acuity even if precision may be lacking for equity and efficiency measurements, actions and reallocation of resources (6,7 and 11).

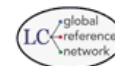
